M MARINI

et within the enclave of couture brands at the Concourse Level of Suria KLCC, M Marini is part of Modesto Marini's chain of F&B endeavours in Kuala Lumpur since the inception of Marini's on 57. Branded as a premium Italian cafe serving caviar and champagne, M Marini exudes a contemporary Italianate ambience anchored by a minimalist backdrop that is accented by classical furnishing with opulent upholstery, marble finishes and unexpected optical punctuations.

Black marquina marble wall encapsulates the cafe's subtly illuminated underwall lights, visually suspending the entire island. The interior maintains the meticulous execution of lavish marble and granite, sumptuous damask and ornate cast iron table legs in an open layout fusing dining and bar. The dark palette of the background surfaces juxtaposes against the off-white furniture and upholstered seating, softening the otherwise masculine foundation. Paying homage to Etruscan mirrors is the bronze mirror finishing for the shelves at the bar.

This allegory of modern clean lines with eclectic measures of baroque and classical hints is further enhanced by symbols of strength and freedom in the form of iconic art replicas, juxtaposed against playful contemporary pieces. 3/1

BRITISHINDIA STORE (SUNWAY)







he refurbishment of the existing BritishIndia store was conceived to mirror and enhance the quality and standard of its exclusive apparel lines. Indo-Saracenic latticework on the shopfront echoes the romanticism of the British Raj, which inspired the spirit of brand.

Soft off-whites encompass the flooring, ceiling and carpentry finishes within, providing a neutral base while giving a sense of spaciousness. Exposed soffits in charcoal grey provide contrast and highlight the display of visual merchandise, altogether enhancing the thematic quality of apparel and accessory displays. The apparel lines are sinuously displayed, one after another, in the

manner of drawing rooms and salons of colonial edifices of the past.

BritishIndia's junior line JustB is conceptualised as 'a store within a store'. Its internal shopfront of steel frames and perforated panels are inspired by BritishIndia's shopfront latticework. 36
